Vinnytsia is the most transparent city according to the results of the transparency rating of the 50 largest cities of Ukraine from the International Center for Policy Studies.

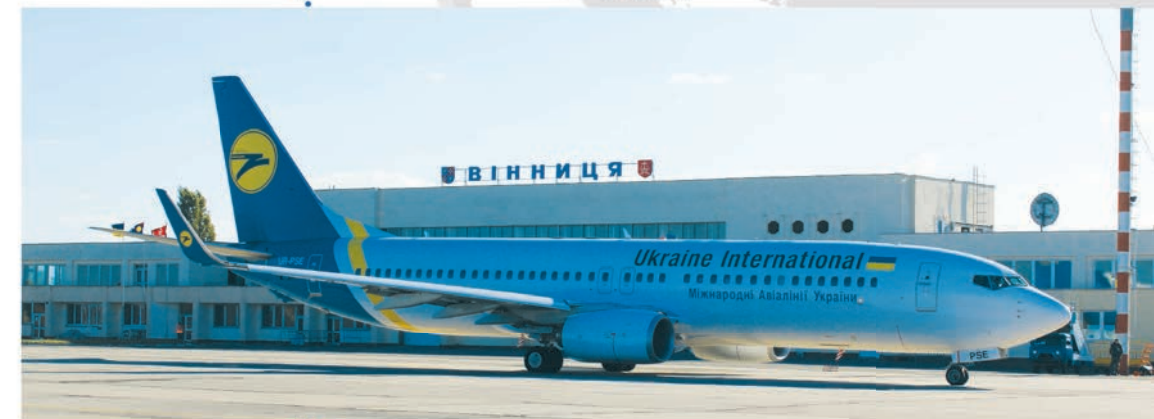

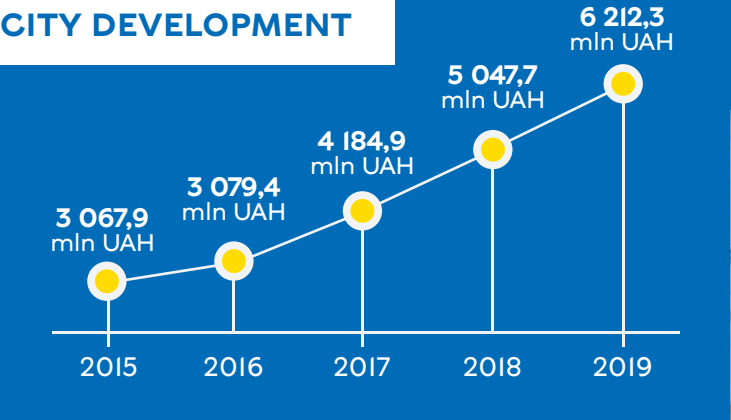

Vinnytsia International Airport is the only one in Central Ukraine between the main regional and capital city airports. It also covers the north of Moldova.

The airport is a municipal company 100% owned by Vinnytsia City Territorial Community. It is located at a distance of 7.5 km east of Vinnytsia railway station.

It has a reinforced concrete runway 2500x42 meters and is able to serve aircrafts of A320 and B737NG families. Since 2016, the network of routes includes the following destinations: Warsaw, Tel Aviv (regular flights), Antalya, Sharm El Sheikh, and Dalaman (charter flights).

It also has the experience in servicing annual charter programs for pilgrims from Tel Aviv.

Among the main airlines using the airport are domestic ones: UIA, Windrose and foreign :LOT (Poland), and TAROM (Romania).

Modern transport infrastructure of Vinnytsia, geographical location and developed industry form the preconditions for the creation of a powerful logistics hub in the city.

BIKE PATHS

RECONSTRUCTION OF COSMONAVTIV AVENUE AND ZAMOSTIANSKA STREET



Recently, a comprehensive renovation of the streets with the creation of a modern public recreational space has been carried out.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT



A system of municipal bicycle rental has been introduced with the support of the Swiss Confederation. There are 25 stations for 180 bicycles.

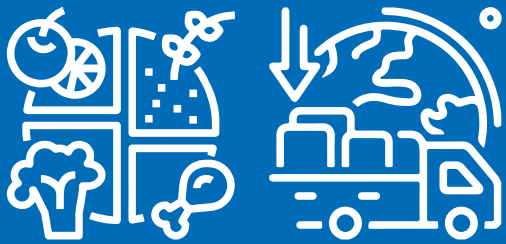

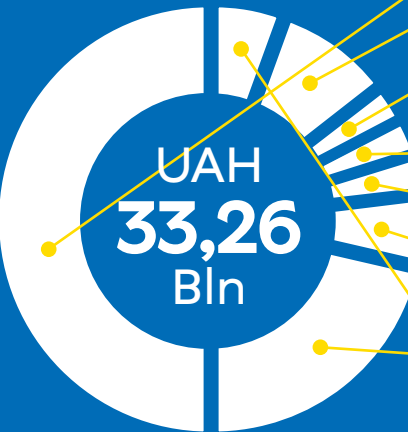

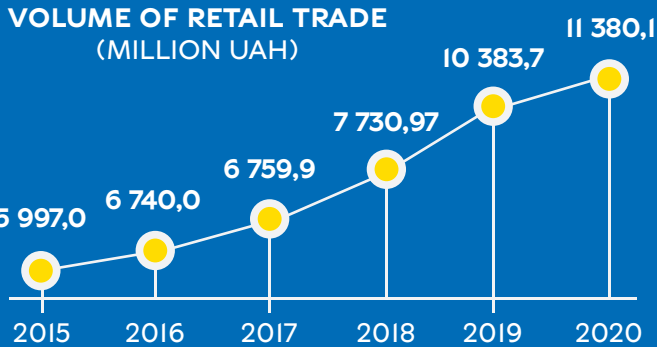

Vinnytsia Municipal Center of Innovation (VMCI)

The municipal enterprise was established to attract investment in the city's economy, provide favorable conditions for business, improve the city investment image as well as ensure economic development and increase Vinnytsia competitiveness.

VMCI is working on:

- Development and arrangement of Vinnytsia Industrial Park (as a management company);
- Creation of Innovation and Technology Park "Crystal".

Sikorsky Challenge Startup School

VVinnytsia National Technical University based on Sikorskyi Challenge Startup School offers a cycle of trainings for startups using the world's best methods and with the participation of leading trainers from around the world, including Israel.

The innovative ecosystem Sikorskyi Challenge is supported by NTUU «KPI» and Kyiv Polytechnic Science Park.



Municipal Situation Center

- In 2018, the Center won the «Best Practices of Local Self-Government» competition in the field of creating a safe living environment.
- In 2019, the system of traffic management - Green Wave - was introduced on the main city roads that has allowed drivers, at observance of speed of 50 km/h, to reduce the travel time 30% on average.
- In 2020, the Center has started to use the face recognition technology based on artificial intelligence.

- development of IT infrastructure and training of IT industry;

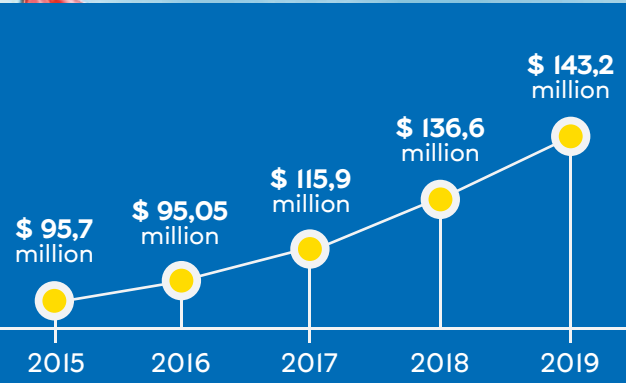

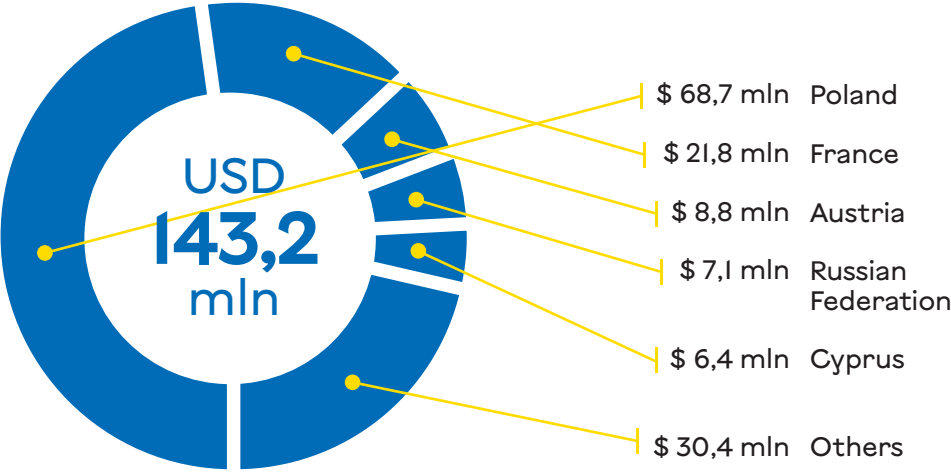

VOLUME OF FDI

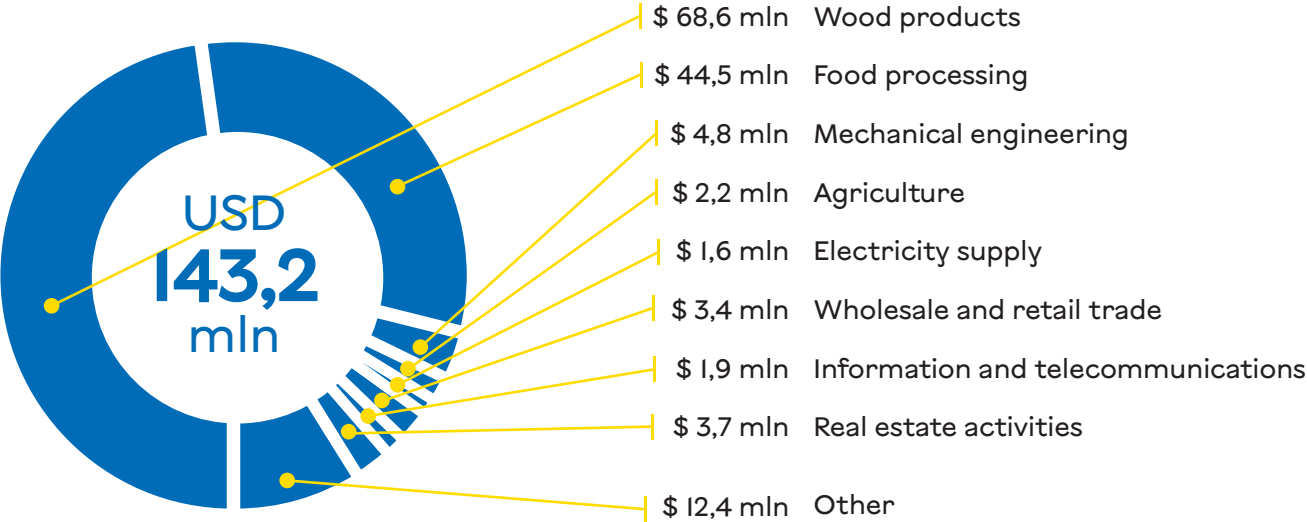


GEOGRAPHICAL STRUCTURE OF FDI

PARTNERS

Cooperation with the International Technical Assistance Project «Partnership for Local Economic Development and Democratic Governance» (PLEDDG Project), implemented by the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) and financed by Global Affairs Canada, aimed at increasing the capacity of local authorities to democratize governance and local economic development; creating a favorable environment for the development of small and medium-sized businesses; supporting the process of decentralization and integrated development.

Cooperation with the German government organization Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH in the field of efficient public administration, energy efficiency and sustainable economic development.

In 2011, Vinnytsia joined the European initiative «Covenant of Mayors», within the framework of which the total consumption of fuel and energy resources was reduced by 21.1% in 2020; CO² emissions were reduced by 13%.

In 2019, Vinnytsia joined the “Covenant of Mayors on Climate and Energy” initiative, committing itself to reduce the CO² emissions (and possibly other greenhouse gases) in the city by 30% by 2030.

Mayor of Vinnytsia Serhii Morhunov was awarded as a winner of the rating “Mayors-Innovators 2017” - the International Summit of Mayors and Ukrainian Truth WESTERN NIS ENTERPRISE FUND.

In June 2015, Vinnytsia was the first in Ukraine to receive the European Energy Award certificate from the Government of Switzerland for its achievements in the field of energy efficiency. In 2019, the city successfully passed (re) certification and received a score of 62.3%, which is 8.3% higher than in 2015.

Cooperation with the State Secretariat for Economic Affairs of the Swiss Confederation (SECO) in the field of energy efficiency, sustainable mobility, development of the city infrastructure.

Vinnytsia has received three of the four prestigious awards of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe: the European Diploma, the Flag of Honour, and the Plaque of Honour.



TOURISM AND LEISURE

Currently, the image of Vinnytsia is rapidly changing, acquiring more and more European features. Since the first written mention in 1363, Vinnytsia has undergone many trials and many joyful events.

Capuchin Church, Jesuit Monastery, Dominican Cathedral, the famous Mury Walls and the remains of the mysterious caves that once connected all these buildings, currently tell about the turbulent times of the 17th and 18th centuries.

Magdeburg law and the advent of the railway made the city a real magnet for traders, entrepreneurs and tourists. During its prosperity, Vinnytsia adorned itself with architectural masterpieces - modern estates and secular buildings, which still delight the traveler's eye. Architect Hryhorii Artynov has forever inscribed his name in the history of the city.

During the Ukrainian Revolution of 1917–1920, Vinnytsia became the capital of the Ukrainian People's Republic three times. However, in a struggle, the country lost its chance for independence for a long time... During the Soviet era, Vinnytsia gained the status of an industrial giant. However, on this background, it experienced famine and mass repressions. The city and the hardships of World War II did not go unnoticed, as evidenced by the remains of the Werewolf pond and a number of memorials and monuments. Having regained its strength after the tragedies and legacy of totalitarian epochs, the city is developing dynamically and is actively using its potential. International airport, road, bus and rail connections to all corners of the country and abroad. Creative hubs and large-scale cultural and artistic projects, various professional events and festivals. Galleries, theaters, museums. Fountains, murals, sculptures. Forests, parks, lakes and the incomparable Southern Bug-God ... Vinnytsia surprises and inspires every day!

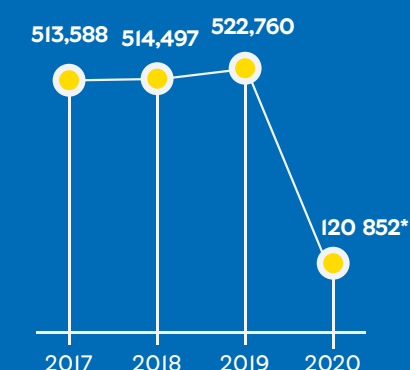

The concept of Vinnytsia Industrial Park was approved by the decision No. 2120 of the session of Vinnytsia City Council dated 24.04.2015.

By the Order No 1172 of the Ministry of Economic Development as of 15.07.2016, Vinnytsia Industrial Park, the initiator of which is Vinnytsia City Council, was included in the Register of industrial parks.

The purpose of its creation is to attract investments into the city's economy, provide favorable conditions for the functioning and development of industrial enterprises, improve the city's investment image, ensure economic development and increase competitiveness, create new jobs, intensify revenues on all budget levels, develop modern production and market infrastructure, and support the greening of enterprises.

The functional purpose: production of food, beverages and tobacco goods; textile production, production of clothes, leather and other materials; mechanical engineering, except for repair and installation of machines and equipment; manufacture of furniture, other products, repair and installation of machinery and equipment; logistics, service and more.

It is planned to create 3840 new jobs by 2026.

The project is envisaged by Vinnytsia City Territorial Community Development Strategy 2030.

Vinnytsia Industrial Park has been recognized as the winner of the Golden Plot competition within the Polish Aid Program for the Development of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland project «Increasing the Competitiveness of Ukrainian Regions and the Development of Polish-Ukrainian Economic Cooperation».

The concept of the Industrial Park Vinnytsia Cluster of Refrigeration Engineering was approved by the Decision No. 693 of the session of Vinnytsia City Council as of 28.04.2017.

By the order No. 799 of the Ministry of Economic Development dated 31.05.2017, Vinnytsia Cluster of Refrigeration Engineering Industrial Park, initiated by Vinnytsia City Council and PJSC Ukrainian Beer Company, was included in the Register of Industrial Parks.

In 2018, Green Cool LLC became the first company to operate in the park. Currently, the staff is about 600 people. According to the Development Concept, 2,000 people will be working by 2024.

The purpose of creating a joint industrial park Vinnytsia Cluster of Refrigeration Engineering is to ensure economic development and increase the competitiveness of the city, create new jobs and manufacture competitive products.

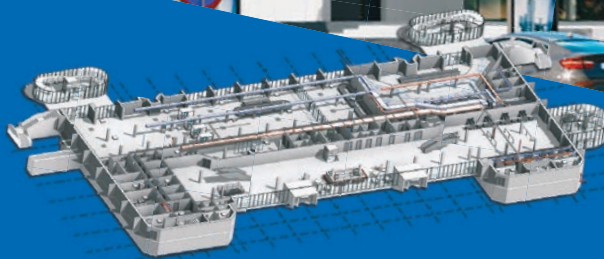

The airport is located at a distance of:

- 13 km from the city center and 3 km to the territory of Industrial Parks;
- 1 km to the E 40 European highway;
- 12 km to the E 583 European highway.

The implementation of the investment project for the reconstruction of the passenger terminal of Vinnytsia International Airport will have a significant effect on the development of Vinnytsia region and the Central Ukraine as a whole.

THE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT PROVIDES

- Separation of the international and domestic sectors in the terminal on the ground floor for arrival and on the second floor for departure (with business halls);
- Creation of a new transit zone (3rd floor) and increase of commercial space (Duty Free shops, cafes, etc.);
- Increase the terminal capacity to 380 pax/h in the international sector and 150 pax/h in the domestic sector;
- Arrangement of a VIP-zone for 15 passengers and a conference-zone for 25-30 visitors;
- Bringing aviation equipment and engineering networks to the level of international standards.

The project is envisaged by the State Target Program for the Development of Airports for the period up to 2023 and the Development Strategy of Vinnytsia City Territorial Community 2030.

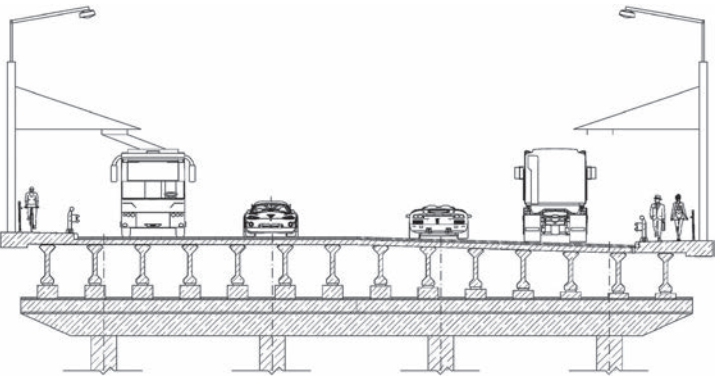

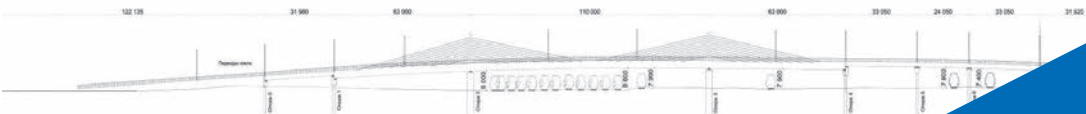


The length of the overpass over the railway will be 1126 m, the cable-stayed bridge - 627 m.
